

## Public Transport Fares In St. Petersburg For 2017

### 1. Single Trip

Type of Ticket	Fare
Tram	40 rubles
Trolleybus	40 rubles
Bus	40 rubles
Subway (by token)	45 rubles

### 2. Podorozhnik Travel Card

Fare per ride by subway within a month:

from 1 to 10	36 rubles
from 11 to 20	35 rubles
from 21 to 30	34 rubles
from 31 to 40	33 rubles
from 41st trip	32 rubles

Fare per ride by tram, trolleybus, bus within a month:

from 1 to 10	31 rubles
from 11 to 20	30 rubles
from 21 to 30	29 rubles
from 31 to 40	28 rubles
from 41st trip	27 rubles
